



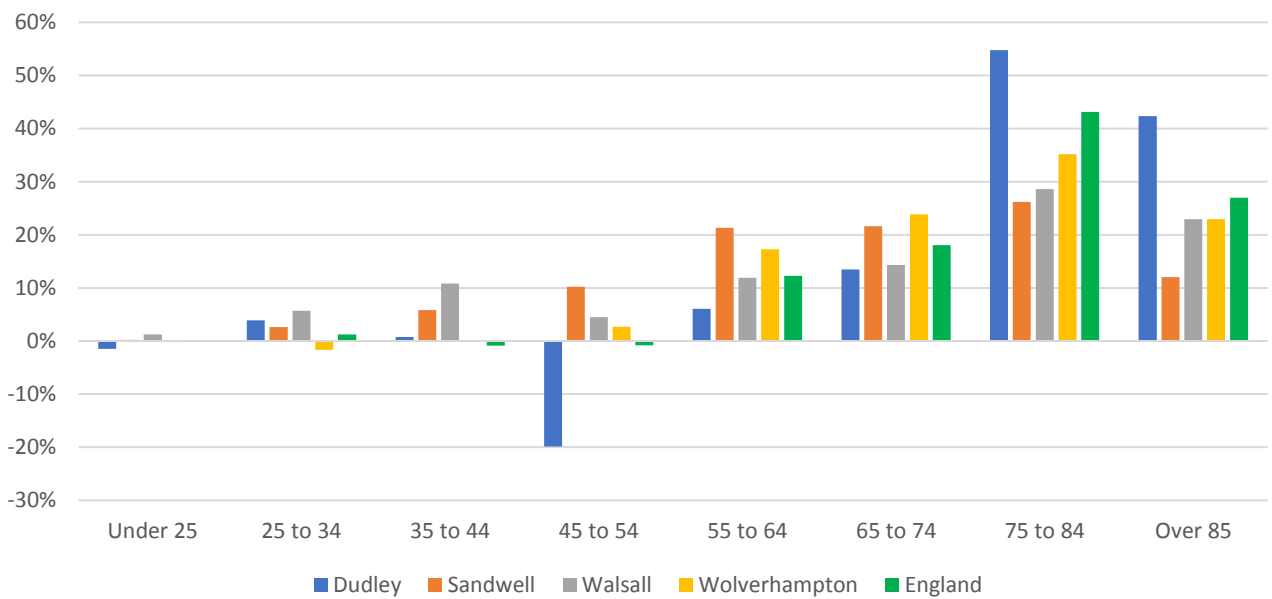
### 2016 Household Projections – Black Country

The number of households in Black Country is projected to increase by almost 69,000 (+15%) over the next 25 years, from 472,000 in 2016 to 541,000 in 2041. This is slightly below the national increase of 17%

- Sandwell is estimated to increase the highest out of the 4 local authorities by 24,490 (+20%), followed by Walsall (17,773 +16%), Wolverhampton (14,364, +14%) and Dudley (12,359, +9%).

In the Black Country, households headed by someone aged 65 years and over account for 75% of the total growth in households between 2016 and 2041 compared to 88% for England.

### Household Growth by age from 2016-2041



- Between 2016-2041 in Dudley, households headed by someone aged 45-54 is expected to decrease by 20% (-1% nationally), however those headed by someone aged 75-84 years is estimated to increase by 55% compared to 43% nationally.
